(7) 在留カードの両面コピー

在留資格が「留学」であることが必要。後日、在留資格を留学に変更する予定の学生は、変 更後、速やかにコピーを再提出すること。休学中で海外在住の人は提出不要。

登録申請書等の提出者のうち一次選考通過者には、6月27日または6月28日に面接を行います。一次選考通過者は、必ず面接を受けて下さい。面接を受けなかった場合は、いかなる理由があっても推薦することが出来ませんのでご注意下さい。また、面接日時等は決定次第、連絡します。なお、面接は日本語又は英語で行い、英語で面接を実施した場合は日本語能力を要件とする奨学金に推薦はできません。

「海洋環境・エネルギー専門職育成国際コース」入学者: 0.5点

Information regarding the application for scholarships awarded upon recommendation by the university in AY 2023

Self-financed international students have an opportunity to receive a recommendation by **TUMSAT** thev apply forprivate scholarships when including **Temporary** Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarhip for Privately-Financed International Students. If you wish to obtain the recommendation, all applicants are requested to submit the following documents by the deadline. After application, candidates undergo a first round (screening of applications) and second round (interviews) of selection, after which they are ranked by the International Students Committee based on their performances. Outstanding students are then recommended for a scholarship.

 - * Please note: This is not required for the residents at TUMSAT's Student Dormitory, International House on campus, University Apartment, and Tokyo International Exchange Center at Odaiba.
- (6) Transcripts(Copy is acceptable)
- Undergraduate students (excluding the first year students): Transcript of the entire undergraduate course.
- The first year students of Master course: Transcript of the entire undergraduate course.
- The second year students of Master course: Transcript of the entire Master course
- Doctoral course students: Transcript of the entire Master course and Doctoral course
- (7) A copy of both sides of your residence card
 Your residence status in Japan must be defined as "Student"(留学). Students who

plan to change their status of residence to "Student" at a later date must resubmit a copy as soon as possible after the change. If you are abroad and on school leave, you do not need to submit it.

(8) Certificate of English and/or Japanese proficiency issued by an outside organization. (If available)

NOTE: Some scholarships require a certificate of English and/or Japanese proficiency.

Passing candidates of the first round of selection are required to attend the interviews on June 27 or June 28. The interview is mandatory. If you do not attend, TUMSAT will not be able to give you a recommendation to apply for private scholarships under any special circumstances. The date of the interview will be emailed as soon as it is decided. Both Japanese and English are acceptable in the interview. If the applicant chooses English, they will not be recommended for scholarships that require Japanese proficiency.

(Evaluation criteria of the first round of selection)

- 1. Academic assessment (Out of 5, specific grade is not disclosed.)
- 2. Type of housing
 - University Apartment, Tokyo International Exchange Center at Odaiba, or apartment under ¥60,000 (1 point)
 - TUMSAT's Student Dormitory, International House, or no rent (0 point)
- 3. Past record of receiving a scholarship

Received scholarships of over \(\pm\)48,000 for more than twice within the past two years (Minus 1 point)

- X Received Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students by JASSO will not be counted as a record.
- 4. Enrollment in the project: Marine Environment and Energy Professional Training International Cources based on collaboration among Japanese, Chinese and Korean (0.5 point)

Upon calculating the evaluation points from No.1 through No.4, those who obtained highest total score will be ranked from the top.
